5. What conclusions can you draw about the lynching statistics in Document 6?
6. Summarize the Supreme Court's justification to allow for segregation based on the majority decision in the Plessy v. Ferguson case (Doc. 9).
7. Summarize the dissenting opinion in the Plessy case (Doc. 10).
